



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **When is Holiday Club?**

Our 2019 Holiday Club, runs from Monday 22 to Friday 26 July (10.15am to 12.45pm) followed by our end of Holiday Club celebration and BBQ party on Sunday 28 July.

### **Who can come to Holiday Club?**

Our Holiday Clubs are designed for anyone in P1 to P7 including those starting in P1 in August. Our evening programme, Team Teen, is available for young adults in S1+.

### **Do I have to register my Child?**

Yes, all children must have a place booked and confirmed in advance. The first day is very busy and pre booking makes it quicker and easier for everyone.

### **Is there a cost?**

Admission is free. Any donations are gratefully received and go towards the costs of crafts, materials and snacks.

### **Do I or my child need to go to Church to attend Holiday Club?**

No, everyone is welcome at the Old Kirk whether they attend Church or not. Many of the children who attend have no Church connection.

### **Does my child have to attend all week?**

No, but if there are days when your child cannot attend, please let us know in advance as demand for places is always very high.

### **Does my child have to attend school in Bo'ness?**

No, most children who come to Holiday Club attend school in Bo'ness but it is not a requirement. Everyone is welcome!

### **Will my child know anyone?**

All our Holiday Clubs are fully inclusive with children put into teams based on their age and school so that they are with other children they may know. Please note that while we are happy to consider requests to place certain children together, this is not always possible due to us ensuring appropriate child/leader ratios.

### **What if my child has special needs or dietary requirements?**

If your child has any additional learning requirements then please provide us with as much information as possible so we can ensure they have the best experience possible. If your child has any dietary requirements then please let us know and we would ask that you provide them with a daily light snack which will be kept separate. All personal information will be treated in strict confidence.

### **What clothes should they wear?**

Something comfortable with flat shoes or trainers. There's a lot of running about and things can get messy and wet!

### **Do they need to bring anything?**

No, everything is provided, including a light snack and drinks.

### **Does my child need to be booked in and collected?**

For safety and security reasons we ask that each child is booked in and collected each day. If you wish your child to go home unaccompanied then please advise us.
